



## Willdan Wins \$27 Million Contract to Redesign and Implement New York City Accelerator Program

ANAHEIM, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Apr. 15, 2026-- Willdan Group, Inc. (NASDAQ: WLDN) announced today that it has been awarded a \$27 million, three-year contract with the New York City Mayor's Office of Climate & Environmental Justice to redesign and implement the NYC Accelerator program. The redesign aims to shift the program's focus from building energy awareness to project implementation.
